- 64-bit Windows Support
- Files larger than 2GB
- Vista Certification (Day +1)
- Network Identity Manager Provider
- Performance Improvements
 - Directory lookups
 - NAT workarounds
 - Background Writes

Major Bug Fixes since Workshop 2006

- vlserver failover (1.5.3)
- BackConnectionsHostNames (1.5.5)
- Background Write Data Loss (1.5.15)
- DST updates (1.5.16)
- OPENAFS-SA-2007-002 (1.5.19)



Windows Specific Known Issues

- No support for UNICODE
 - adverse impact on roaming profiles and redirected folders
- No integration with Microsoft Dfs
- No disconnected mode functionality
- No support for DOS and Extended Attributes
- No support for multiple data streams secureendpoints

Future Plans

- New user interfaces
 - Explorer Shell Extensions
 - Management Console plug-ins
 - Control Panel replacement
- AFS Servers (??)
